Organised since 1887, the mythical Jumping International of Vichy returns this year for the 123th edition under the auspices of the Société Hippique Française. An important historical gathering, thanks to the fact that it is the oldest International French meeting, the Jumping International of Vichy is one of the major events of the equestrian year.

This event of passionate people will take place once more under the summer sun - from the 27th to the 30th June. Whether the public is aficionado or neophyte, they will enjoy an intense schedule full of sport and diverse appealing animations at the wonderful equestrian Sichon showground.





A WORD FROM THE PRESIDENT



Every year, during the beginning of the summer, the Société Hippique Française is pleased to welcome you for its traditional Jumping International at the mystical equestrian Sichon stadium, located in the heart of the Spa town of Vichy. This equestrian event, the oldest International French competition, will celebrate its 123th edition and has been able to adapt, over the decades, to new requirements of the highest International levels. The new sand track, inaugurated in 2018, is today unanimously approved by all the national and international riders as one of the best tracks of France.

Gifted with exceptional accommodation facilities for horses and a lighting system allowing the organization of nocturnal events, the Sichon stadium became a true equestrian pole with International influence.

EDITION 2019



From the **27th to the 30th June**, all eyes of the equestrian world will be on the CSI (Concours de Saut International) in Vichy.

In addition to the 2* label, Young Horses (6 and 7-year-old) will be facing each other in a special CSI for each age group, with the 7-year-old competing in the TOP 7 circuit, a competition comprising forty trials created in 2015 by the French Equestrian Federation and the SHF, while the 6-year-old will be competing in the SHF's Future Elite circuit. These circuits give future champions the opportunity to take part in some of the best national and international competitions in France.



Finally, amateur riders also get to step into the Sichon arena to compete in the CSI Amateur B in front of the legendary Gustave Eiffel grandstand and its audiences. Besides the opportunity to compete alongside the best, this CSI also enables French riders to score points on the CSO FFE – Esthederm Amateur Gold Tour circuit as it is the ninth of sixteen qualifying legs in 2019. The grand finale will be held at the CSI 5* in Lyon from the 1st to 3rd of November.

All in all, the Jumping International of Vichy 2019 comprises twenty-two classes, with prize money totaling almost one hundred thousand euros.



NOT TO BE MISSED

The competition will take place over four days with a packed schedule, including some unmissable competitions such as:

CSI 2*: The Grand Prix

The horse and rider combinations will compete in the qualifying classes for the Grand Prix on Friday and Saturday. The qualifying class on Friday along with Sunday's Grand Prix will allow riders to earn precious points that count towards the LONGINES FEI Rankings. Only the top 60 riders will take part in the GRAND PRIX VICHY COMMUNAUTE on Sunday 30th June at 3.30 pm.

CSI 2*: The 6-bar

The most spectacular competition of the show is of a high-jump class (6 bars) over six obstacles in a straight line, each two strides apart. The height of the obstacles is raised after each round. The winning combination is the one that jumps the highest without knocking down any rails. Last year, Vanessa Norblin won the competition and added her name to the list of prize-winners in Vichy. Children, adults, specialists and newcomers are going to have the opportunity to enjoy this on Saturday evening from 9 pm.


CSI Young Horses

This international class has two age categories: the Future Elite circuit for 6-year-old and the Top 7 circuit for 7-year-old. Both course offer the opportunity to discover future champions who could go on and excel in the most prestigious competitions in a few years' time. An event that's definitely must not be missed if you're looking to spot future great combinations or discover those keeper.

CSI Amateur B

This class, open only to amateur riders from France and abroad, helps establish the rankings of French riders on the Amateur Gold Tour. Riders will be facing each other over two different heights according to their level: the small tour (1m15 in height) and the big tour (1m25 in height).

The penalties

In the event of a refusal or a rail knocked down, the rider will incur either time or jumping penalties.

- · 4 penalties for each rail knocked down
- 4 penalties for a refusal (elimination after the 2nd refusal)
- Elimination for any fall

MEDIA COVERAGE

With the wish to offer the maximum visibility for equestrian sports and to facilitate sales and marketing, the Jumping International of Vichy will once again this year be broadcast live on the SHF video platforms: the **www.shf-video.com** website and the mobile app. Last year, no less than 20,000 users followed the live broadcasts.

The different events of the CSI will be available free of charge all over the world live from the legendary Sichon course allowing owners, relatives, enthusiasts or potential buyers to follow their favorite horses throughout the four days of competition.

Behind-the-scenes news, results and highlights of the four days of competition will also be posted every day on the Jumping International of Vichy Facebook page and on the **www.csi-vichy.com** website which will be regularly updated throughout the event.

SOME HISTORY

The Sichon Equestrian Stadium belongs to the Société Hippique Française, created in 1865, which has been hosting equestrian events since 1887. More than just a sport event, the Jumping International of Vichy is an integral part of the town of Vichy for locals and international riders alike, and it was notably the first CSIO to be held after the Second World War. Many of the major names in equestrian sports have competed here. With its equestrian stadium and racecourse, Vichy is THE horse town par excellence.

The magnificent sand-fibre arena, who will celebrate his first birthday, provides an outstanding stage for horses to display their prowess in front of the magnificent grandstand designed by Gustave Eiffel. The organizers strive to present a top-quality show for highly enthusiastic audiences in Vichy. It has all the ingredients of a truly unforgettable moment.

THEY ARE TALKING ABOUT IT

The Jumping International de Vichy has crossed times. The greatest particularity of the Sichon equestrian stadium is that it is located in the heart of Vichy, where competitors and their entourage can enjoy the comforts of the town's hotels and restaurants. The renovation of the flooring to create a sand-fibre arena signals the start of a new era. The showground will have modernized and optimized services and facilities, which herald a bright future for this international jumping competition, ensuring its place on the international equestrian stage. This is a very positive development that is very much in keeping with the times. Grass surfaces are being replaced partly with the horses' comfort and well-being in mind and partly to guarantee great events whatever the weather. I've ridden here before and it's always been one of my favorite competitions. It's one of the shows that is closest to my heart

The Vichy show is my entire youth. I became French Young Rider Champion here in 1984 after the Olympic Games in Los Angeles. The Sichon showground is highly symbolic for me. The characterful showground, its town-center location. the impressive Gustave Eiffel grandstand, the organization and atmosphere all make this competition an unique event. It's one of a kind and I'm very fond of it. The transformation with the installation of a new sand-fibre footing is a very good thing and very much in keeping with how the sport is evolving >>>

LOOKING BACK ON THE 2018 EDITION

Last year, the Jumping International of Vichy hosted 310 horses and 140 riders competing in 21 classes for prize money totaling 100,000 euros.

10,000 spectators watched the competition at the Sichon showground taking turns in the 1500-seater Gustave Eiffel grandstand.

The CSI** Grand Prix in 2018 saw three French riders take first, second and third places. Benoît Cernin, with Unamour du Suyer, had been crowned winner after facing Olivier Perreau with Venizia d'Aiguilly. Alexandre Fontanelle and Prime Time des Vagues climbed on the third step of the podium.
